What Will I Receive Upon Completion?

A Statement of Attainment will be issued by CTI and a High Risk Work Licence will be issued by WorkSafe Victoria, after lodging your Competent Notice of Assessment Online at a cost of \$66.60.

What Content is covered in the Training?

This course describes the skills and knowledge required to perform rigging at an advanced level including: rigging of gin poles and shear legs, flying foxes and cable ways, guyed derricks and structures, and suspended scaffolds and fabricated hung scaffolds for licensing purposes.

Units

Participants need to complete one unit consisting of:
Licence to perform rigging advanced level

Who Can Undertake the Training?

Students are required to be over 18 years old, competent in written and spoken English and will undertake a Language, Literacy, and Numeracy test prior to commencing the training.

How often do the Courses Run and what is their Duration?

This course is delivered over 4 consecutive days (8 hours per day).

Courses are run regularly throughout the year. Please speak directly to Construction Training International for exact course dates.

Normal operating hours are 7am-5pm.

How is the Course Trained and Assessed?

A Pre Requisite of this course is Intermediate Rigging.

Training and assessment will take place in RTO's training rooms by a qualified Trainer monitoring your progress.

The course is delivered with both theory and practical elements and is completed via a simulated work environment. The delivery of training will include a mixture of classroom delivery, group discussions and individual research.

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Assessment is used to provide you with feedback on your progress and to measure your skills and knowledge against the training qualification requirements and those of the industry. The assessment process may include written questions, case studies and practical demonstrations.

How Much Will it Cost?

The cost of the course can be found on the Course Fee List. This can be accessed via the CTI website or by contacting the CTI Student Administration Department.
